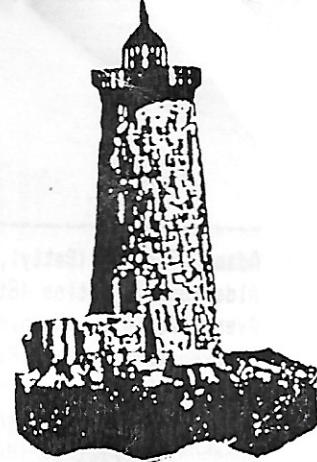


# The Rotary Club of Kittery
