Today, after the Pledge of Allegiance, Song and Prayer, Russ asked us to be seated in silence. In a traditional military ceremony, Chief Master Sergeant Peter Bresciano called the roll for those 17 soldiers from the State of Maine who are still missing and unaccounted for. The reply for each name called was a poignant "Missing in action, Sir". I am certain everyone still holds the image of the table set for these men, with the symbolic pure white cloth and bitter meal representing the intention and hardships of those who cannot be with us.

Chief Master Sergeant Peter Bresciano later spoke of his commitment to attain 100% accountability for the over 92,000 missing of all wars; the World Wars, Korean, and Southeast Asian Wars. He announced the Pease AFB Awareness Council's commissioning of a monument outside the main gate of Pease AFB on September 15th, 1989 to commemorate these POW's and MIA's. .
