He described what is done when a submarine is brought in to be overhauled. There are two crews to man a submarine so that it could be at Sea 100% of the time. When the sub is being overhauled one crew stays with it and they work long hours testing the equipment. It can take up to two years to overhaul a submarine. He also discussed how the Shipyard hires their personnel. Captain Bowman is a very charming man and it was a pleasure to hear him describe the military role in the community.
